

KPI Green Energy to raise \$363 million from SBI, top executives say

MUMBAI, Sept 16 (Reuters) - India's KPI Green Energy (KPIG.NS) ☐ is set to raise 32 billion rupees (\$363.39 million) through a loan from the country's largest lender to expand production capacity at its renewable power plants, top KPI executives told Reuters on Tuesday.

The loan approval comes amid the Indian government's green energy push <u>targeting</u> 500 gigawatts of non-fossil capacity by 2030, and, according to analysts, stands out as one of the larger deals in the sector's recent history.

KPI Green Energy develops, builds, and manages renewable power facilities, specialising in solar, wind and hybrid power solutions.

The company is raising the funds via a 20-year loan at an interest rate of 8.45% from the State Bank of India, which will be disbursed in a staggered manner over the next 1.5 years, Chief Financial Officer Salim Yahoo told Reuters.

"By 2027, we will finish all our projects in hand in IPP", said Chairman and Managing Director Dr. Faruk G. Patel, referring to its Independent Power Producer business, "which will generate about 10 billion rupees in revenue."

The company also issued its first green bond on Tuesday, planning to raise 6.7 billion rupees at a coupon of 8.5% per annum.

The rupee-denominated five-year bond was externally credit-enhanced - its rating was given a boost by a 65% guarantee from GuarantCo, a Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG) company.

"Without the guarantee, we would have had to pay a 14-15% coupon to raise funds via equity or quasiequity instruments," Patel said.

The guarantee effectively raised the instrument's credit rating from A+ to AA+ rating by CRISIL and ICRA, Yahoo said.

Aseem Infrastructure Finance subscribed to a majority of the bonds, while Jio Finance and SBI Capital Markets took the rest, Yahoo added.

SBI Capital Markets was the sole arranger for the issue, the executives said.

For the renewable field, I believe this will be a very good instrument for the project owners and at the same time for the structured investors," said Faruk G Patel, chairman and managing director in a conversation with FE. He further said that Aseem Infrastructure Finance was the major investor followed by Jio Credit and SBI Capital Markets.

Meanwhile, the company is also planning to Rs 3,200 crore through a loan from the State Bank of India for expansion plans at an interest rate of 8.45%. The disbursement will happen in a phased manner in 1.5 years, said Salim Yahoo, CFO, KPI Green Energy.

"The entire project would be of around Rs 4,400 crore, out of which bank finance will be around 75% and 25% from equity and bond market," said Yahoo.

Moreover, renewable energy will tap the overseas market through dollar bonds in FY27, Patel told FE. "We wanted to create that picture in the market so that in the future, whenever we want to raise any money, and especially from the international funds or anything, ESG compliance will be an important part. So for that purpose, we wanted to go through a bond route and that especially a green bond route," said Yahoo.

KPI Green Energy raised Rs 670 crore through India's first externally credit-enhanced green bonds maturing in five years. The bonds got listed on the National Stock Exchange of India (NSE) on September 16.

The bonds bear a coupon rate of 8.5 percent per annum with a quarterly amortising profile and has been rated with ratings of AA+(CE) by CRISIL and ICRA according to the press release.

"Aseem Infrastructure has invested majority of the amount, followed by Jio Credit and SBICaps," Salim Suleman Yahoo, Chief Financial Officer of the company told Moneycontrol.

The issuance is backed by a 65 percent guarantee from GuarantCo, part of the Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG). "The remaining guarantee is based on internal books," said Faruk G. Patel, Chairman and Managing Director in an conversation with Moneycontrol.

Bond proceeds will be utilised to expand KPI Green's solar, wind, and hybrid power portfolio, primarily across Gujarat. The projects financed are expected to provide clean electricity access to nearly 210,000 people and several businesses annually, while avoiding more than 344,000 tCO2e each year, a release said.

SBICaps were the arrangers for the issue.

Patel added that the company may go for the dollar bonds and may raise it after 2027. He did not mention any quantum of the amount that the company will raise through dollar bonds.

As the country continues its push towards clean energy, such financial instruments are likely to play a crucial role in funding the transition to a low-carbon economy.

KPI Green Energy Locks In Major Loan And Green Bond Backing

What's going on here?

KPI Green Energy just secured a \$363 million loan from State Bank of India and launched a credit-enhanced green <u>bond</u> – setting the stage for a major play in India's renewable energy ramp-up.

What does this mean?

India aims to build a massive 500 gigawatts of non-fossil fuel capacity by 2030, but making progress on that scale takes both deep pockets and creative financing. Enter KPI Green Energy, which develops and manages solar, wind, and hybrid power projects. The company's latest move involves a 20-year, 32-billion-rupee loan at 8.45% interest from State Bank of India, plus its first-ever green bond: a 6.7-billion-rupee, five-year issue with backing from GuarantCo for added security. Thanks to that guarantee, the bond earned an upgraded AA+ rating and a lower interest rate than typical equity fundraising. This combo attracted major institutional buyers like Aseem Infrastructure Finance and Jio Finance, signaling growing confidence in India's clean energy pipeline. KPI Green's projects are set for completion by 2027 and expected to generate roughly 10 billion rupees in annual revenue.

Why should I care?

For markets: Cheaper capital could accelerate sector growth.

KPI Green Energy's success locking in long-term funding at lower rates shows mature renewable firms can access more affordable debt – driving down project costs and drawing interest from big investors. The use of credit enhancement and surging green bond demand could reshape how India's renewables are financed, potentially attracting even more domestic and global capital looking for steady, climate-focused returns.

The bigger picture: India's financing model for green energy gets an upgrade.

These moves demonstrate how clever structuring and external guarantees can pull in bigger pools of money at lower risk, backing India's push for clean energy. If more firms adopt this playbook, India's renewable rollout could pick up speed – helping the country slash its dependence on fossil fuels while reducing risk for both investors and lenders.



KPI Green Energy Launches India's First Externally credit-enhanced Green Bond

GUJARAT, SURAT | 16th SEPTEMBER 2025: KPI Green Energy Limited has achieved a historic milestone by launching India's first externally credit-enhanced Green Bond, marking a significant advancement in financing the country's renewable energy transition.

Worth Rs. 670 crore, the bond carries a coupon rate of 8.50% p.a. with a five-year quarterly amortising structure. This pioneering issuance is backed by a 65% guarantee from GuarantCo, part of the Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG).

GuarantCo is funded by the governments of the UK, Switzerland, Australia, Sweden, the Netherlands (via FMO), France, and Global Affairs Canada. With GuarantCo's strong credit ratings (AA- Fitch, A1 Moody's), the bond has secured an AA+ (CE) rating from leading Indian agencies CRISIL and ICRA.

Proceeds from the issuance will be used to expand KPI Green Energy's solar, wind, and hybrid energy capacity. The project is expected to supply clean power to approximately 2,10,000 people annually, while reducing carbon emissions by over 3,44,000 tonnes of CO₂ equivalent each year.

This landmark bond not only supports KPI Green Energy's sustainability goals but also sets a precedent for deepening India's green capital markets. It opens the door for other corporates to explore innovative, credit-enhanced financial instruments, accelerating the development of clean infrastructure across the country.

Dr. Faruk G. Patel, Chairman & Managing Director, said, "We have borrowed this planet from our future generations. It is our duty to leave behind clean air and a healthier world. Renewable energy is not just business, but a noble cause for nature, humanity, and all living beings, and we are committed to making a significant impact."

Since its inception in 2008, KPI Green has commissioned over 1 GW of renewable capacity and has over 3 GW in the pipeline. The KP Group has energised 6 GW of projects, which is equivalent to planting 260 million trees, and is targeting 10 GW capacity by 2030.

India's first externally credit enhanced green bond issuance is guaranteed by GuarantCo



GuarantCo, part of the Private Infrastructure Development Group (PIDG), has provided a partial credit guarantee (65 per cent) for an up to INR 6.7 billion (c. USD 76.5 million) first green bond issuance by KPI Green Energy, a publicly listed (BSE: 542323, NSE: KPIGREEN) renewable energy developer and operator in India.

This is the first partially guaranteed externally credit enhanced domestic green bond issuance by a renewable developer in a market typically dominated by larger firms, both from the private sector and state-backed entities.

The proceeds of the bond will help KPI Green to expand its solar, wind and hybrid power portfolio capacity across the states of Gujarat. The project will provide c. 210,000 people and several businesses with improved access to clean electricity, while being forecast to avoid more than 344,000 tCO2e.

This transaction will mobilise c. USD 175 million of domestic institutional capital (e.g. infrastructure debt funds, mutual funds, insurance) into renewables. The bonds will help KPI Green diversify its funding base beyond its existing debt providers, which are mostly banks.

The project will contribute to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals 7 (affordable and clean energy), 8 (decent work and economic growth) and 13 (climate action).

GuarantCo's guarantee has helped the five-year bond to achieve a credit rating of AA+(CE) by both CRISIL and ICRA, enabling wider investor participation in such bonds. A four-notch rating upgrade underscores the strength of GuarantCo's guarantee and credit risk management. The bonds will be listed at the National Stock Exchange (NSE).

KPI Green is also expected to benefit from a PIDG Technical Assistance grant for this transaction.

Nishant Kumar, Managing Director of Asia Investments at GuarantCo and Head of Coverage – Asia at PIDG, said:

"We are delighted to have closed this transaction with KPI Green Energy that will support systematic growth in India's debt capital markets. This transaction is also pioneering as India's first credit-enhanced green bond, which we hope will provide inspiration to other firms in this market segment to stimulate market transformation. India needs to add new renewable energy capacity of 300GW to achieve an installed generation capacity of 500GW from renewable sources by 2030 and domestic debt capital market needs to play an integral role in achieving this goal.

"GuarantCo, part of the Private Infrastructure Development Group, is at the forefront of market innovation and creating replicable structures. We hope this will help kick-start unlocking the vast domestic institutional capital for financing sustainable infrastructure in India."

Dr Faruk G Patel - Chairman at KPI Green Energy, said:

"KPI Green Energy has issued its first green bond of up to ₹6.7 bn—the first externally credit-enhanced by a renewable developer in India—backed by a 65% GuarantCo (PIDG) guarantee, rated AA+ by CRISIL and ICRA, and listed on NSE. Proceeds will expand our solar, wind and hybrid projects in Gujarat, improving clean power for ~210,000 people, avoiding >344,000 tCO₂e, and mobilising ~USD 175m of domestic capital while diversifying our funding and paving the way for ESG and potential USD issuances. This milestone advances SDGs 7, 8 and 13; we thank our partners and investors."

Business व्यापार: केपीआई ग्रीन एनर्जी ने भारत के पहले बाह्य ऋण-वर्धित ग्रीन बॉन्ड के ज़रिए 670 करोड़ रुपये जुटाए, जो पाँच साल में परिपक्क होंगे। ये बॉन्ड 16 सितंबर को नेशनल स्टॉक एक्सचेंज ऑफ़ इंडिया (एनएसई) में सुवीबद्ध हुए।

प्रेस विञ्चप्ति के अनुसार, इन बॉन्ड पर 8.5 प्रतिशत प्रति वर्ष की कूपन दर है और इनका परिशोधन त्रैमासिक है। क्रिसिल और आईसीआरए ने इन्हें AA+(CE) रेटिंग दी है। कंपनी के मुख्य वित्तीय अधिकारी सलीम सुलेमान याहू ने बताया, "असीम इंफ्रास्ट्रक्वर ने ज्यादातर राशि का निवेश किया है, उसके बाद जियों क्रेडिट और एसबीआईकैंप्स का स्थान है।"

यह बॉन्ड प्राइवेट इंफ्रास्ट्रकार डेवलपमेंट ग्रुप (पीआईडीजी) के एक भाग, गारंटको की 65 प्रतिशत गारंटी द्वारा समर्थित है। अध्यक्ष फारुक जी, पटेल ने कहा, "शेष गारंटी आंतरिक बहीखातों पर आधारित है।"


